- 2  **Angelonia Bicolor**
 - New color in large flowering, upright growing "summer snapdragons". Grown from cuttings - available in pots, not flats. Great in beds or as a thriller in smaller containers.
- 3  **4 Additional Colors**
- 4  **Angelonia Serenita Series**
 - Compact series that includes 'Raspberry', 'Purple', 'White', 'Lavender Pink', and mix. Grows 8-10" tall.
 - NOT available in 'Blue'. Stick with 'Serena' for Blue.
- 5  **Angelonia Serena Blue**
 - A new color for the Serena series. A more compact and economical Angelonia, growing 10-14" tall.
- 6  **Argyranthemum 'Butterfly'**
 - The most heat tolerant of the marguerite daisies. Can be left alone or deadheaded for best performance.
- 7  **Annual Asclepias 'Silky Red' and 'Silky Yellow'**
 - Strong upright growers with flowers from spring until fall. Great for attracting butterflies.
- *8  **Begonia 'Dragon Wing'**
 - Ideal for shade or part shade but will also survive in full sun if grown from larger transplants. Rose too.
- 9  **Begonia 'BIG'**
- 10  **Begonia 'BIG' Pink one**

- 11  **Begonia Whopper**
- Even bigger than 'Big' begonias. An alternative for impatiens growers. 18-24" tall. Grown from seed!
- 12  **Fairyland Begonia**
- The first seed grown semi-double blooming wax-leafed begonia. Three colors - green leaf.
- 13  **Begonia boliviensis 'Bonfire'**
- 14  **Begonia Crackling Fire Pink**
- Compact and floriferous Begonia in 8 colors including 'Pink', 'Dark Red', 'Orange', 'Yellow', 'White', 'Orange Red', and 'Red'. For shade or part shade.
- 15  **Begonia Waterfall Series**
- Very floriferous and cascading. Will thrive in both sun or shade. 'Encanto Orange', 'Encanto Red', and 'Rainbow Falls' (Pink)
- 16  **Bidens**
- Excellent trailing plant with potential as a groundcover or component in combination planters. Typically very heat and cold tolerant. Select sterile or almost sterile cultivars when you can: 'Sun Drop' ('14) or 'Bidy Gonzalez' ('14)
- 17  **Calibrachoa/ Petcoa**
- Calibrachoa provide best performance in low pH environments (pH buffered Potting Soil !!!)
- 18  **Supercal Petcoa**
- Bigger flowers, great colors, and most importantly, better performance in a broad range of pHs
- 19  **Canna 'Orange Punch'**
- 20  **Canna 'Pretoria' aka 'Bengal Tiger'**
- No maintenance foliage for sun or shade with the bonus of











vibrant orange flowers.

- 21  **Canna 'Australia'**
- 22  **Canna from seed**
- 'Tropical' Series includes 5 colors: red, rose, salmon, white, and yellow
 - 'Tropical Rose' is an All American Selections winner
 - All grow 2-3' tall
 - Perfect green foliage
- 23  **Canna 'Tropical Bronze'**
- Like other varieties in the 'Tropical' Series, this one is short at 3-4'. Beautiful foliage, orange/red flowers, and seed grown.
- 24  **Cannas in the landscape**
- Very dramatic!
- 25  **Cleome 'Rosalita'**
- Unlike almost every other cleome, this one never goes to seed. It flowers and flowers all season. 2-3' tall and wide.
- 26  **Centaurea gymnocarpa**
- Underused thriller - Ideal for containers. Tolerates heat and drought. May require a pinch late season. Beautiful with many other components.
- 27  **Cardoon (Hardy artichoke)**
- Biennial that can overwinter in protected sites. Large silvery leaves - very architectural. Good in beds or pots. Drought tolerant.
- 28  **Coleus 'Indian Summer'**
- 29  **Coleus 'New Henna'**
- 30  **Coleus Colorblaze Keystone Kopper**
- For sun or shade. Grown from cuttings.
- 31  **Coleus 'Honey Crisp'**










- Grown from cuttings. Sun or Shade.
- 32  **Cordyline 'Torbay Dazzler'**
- 33  **Cordyline 'Electric Pink'**
- 34  **Cuphea 'Firecracker'**
 - Very heat tolerant with vibrant bicolored flowers of scarlet and violet.
- 35  **Dahlia 'Candy Eyes'**
 - 'Candy Eyes' has beautiful pink and white striped flowers with bright orange stamens but it also has deeply serrated mahogany leaves that are showy with or without the flowers. Bred in New Zealand. Grows 16-20" tall. Look for more common series such as 'Happy' and Mystic'
- 36  **Duranta erecta 'Gold Mound'**
 - Filler/thriller for sun to part sun with waxy, bright gold leaves. Great in combinations for contrast with darker leaves.
- 37  **Euphorbia 'Silver Fog'**
 - Sold as one of a dozen or so cultivars now. For Sun or Shade. The perfect filler for any combination in pots or beds.
- 38  **Gaura 'Passionate Rainbow;**
 - Upright grower to 2' tall with beautiful tricolored leaves usually topped with pink flowers. Perennial.
- 39  **Pelargonium 'Calliope Dark Red'**
- 40  **Geranium Calliope Burgundy**
 - 'Calliope Dark Red' is the standard by which all other geraniums are measured. Now we have 3 new colors in the series. Superior heat tolerance.
- 41  **Geranium Calliope Hot Pink**
- 42  **Geranium Calliope Lavender Rose**
- 43  **Gerbera Daisy Patio Rocky Mountain**

- Everblooming series with very big flowers all season long. Growing up to 24" tall.
- 44  **Gerbera Garvinea (Sweet Series)**
- The new generation in Garvinea. Several colors to choose from in the series. Availability VERY low.
- 45  **Gomphrena 'Qis Carmine'**
- Heat tolerant, seed grown annual in carmine or purple with exceptional heat tolerance. Comes short too.
- 46  **Gomphrena 'Gnome'**
- Sold under a few different names. Only growing 10-15" tall. Don't buy white.
- 47  **Helenium 'Dakota Gold'**
- Seed grown annual that requires no maintenance. Excellent heat tolerance. Great in beds or pots.
 - Height: 10-15" Space: 10-15"
- 48  **Hibiscus (annual) 'Mahogany Splendor'**
- Seed grown. Up to 4' tall but very effective as a back drop in larger beds. Sun to part Sun.
- 49  **Impatiens 'Divine Series'**
- The most economical alternative to traditional, downy mildew prone impatiens. Will be available in flats in '13. Available in...
- 50  **Divine in a Pack**
- Pinks, reds, white, violet, 2 oranges, lavender, and several beautiful mixtures.
- 51  **Impatiens 'Divine Pink Pearl'**
- This is what you can expect from the Divine series in the landscape. Not too bad.
- 52  **New Colors for 2014 include:**
White Blush, Blue Pearl, Burgundy, & Scarlet Bronze Leaf
- 53  **Other companies are pursuing the Seed grown New**










Guinea

- 54  **Impatiens Sunpatiens Compact Orange and Compact White Imp.**
- This is your high performance alternative to traditional impatiens. Can grow in sun OR shade. 18 count flats.
- 55  **Choose from a broad range of colors.**
- 56  **Cost per square foot may be lower than you might think!**
- Traditional impatiens on 10" centers: 14.4/10sq.ft.
 - Sunpatiens on 18" centers: 4.4/10sq.ft.
- 57  **Ipomoea (Sweet Potato Vine)**
- New 'Chpotle' shown on left. Available compact or trailing. Sun or shade. For beds or pots.
- 58  **Iresine 'Cherry'**
- Thriller for Sun. No flowers. Grows to about 18-24" tall. Waxy, burgundy red leaves.
- 59  **Lantana**
- Self-cleaning filler or spiller (white or lavender) for heat. Many colors available.
- 60  **Kale 'Redbor'**
- Frost tolerance and heat tolerance. Spring planted beds are beautiful until fall when plants grow tall and crooked.
 - Great to plant in fall too.
- 61  **Lobularia 'Stream' Series**
- An alternative to Proven Winner's 'Snow Princess'. From left to right: White, Summer, Lavender, Silver.
- 62  **Lobularia 'Frosty Knight'**
- From Proven Winners. White with variegated foliage. Not obvious when viewed from a distance.
- 63  **Lobularia 'Silverstream Blue'**
- Another alternative from another supplier. The Silverstream

series offers a white as well.

- 64  **Marigold regular and triploid**
 'Zenith' shown above, is a sterile (not seed producing) cultivar with exceptional vigor and heat tolerance. No deadheading required. Very rarely offered.
- 65  **Melampodium**
 • An alternative yellow "groundcover" to swap with Helenium 'Dakota Gold'. Very heat tolerant.
- 66  **Nicotiana sylvestris**
 • Elegant, architectural plant with fragrant white flowers. Usually reseeds.
- 67  **Nicotiana 'Perfume' series**
 • Available in Lime, Purple, Red, Pink, etc.
 • Taller than most hybrids (24") with fragrant flowers at night. Pots or beds. Good thru late summer.
- 68  **Nierembergia 'Lara' Blue and White**
- 69  **Pennisetum 'Fireworks' and 'Skyrocket'**
 • 'Rubrum' is available everywhere but overused. Here are two interesting alternatives with pink variegation or green/white variegation.
- 70  **Pentas**
 • Heat tolerant. Attracts butterflies. Short cultivars (15") and tall ones (24") are available in pinks, reds, violets, and white.
- 71  **Petunia 'Easy Wave Pink Dawn' & 'Easy Wave Neon Rose'**
 • Two new colors to add to the already enormous pallet of Wave petunias. 'Neon Rose' looks like the popular 'Vista Bubblegum' and should perform very well (like other Wave petunias). No dead heading is required. Full to part sun.
- 72  **Petunia 'Easy Wave Great Lakes Mix' & 'Easy Wave Opposites Attract'**

- With new colors comes new mixtures. These are two new mixtures in the Wave series. Some of the mixtures are not as pretty as these.

- 73  **Petunia 'Shock Wave Coconut'**
- Shock Waves have not been terribly popular but they are great performers. The form tight mounds rather than spreading masses and produce small flowers. This image was taken late summer in Michigan. The plant was perfect.
- 74  **Vegetative Petunias in a rainbow of colors.**
- Typically sold in pots or hanging baskets. Great colors including yellow, orange, and black.
- 75  **Don't overlook Petunias the next few years!!!**
- Bizzare color combinations you can't imagine.
- 76  **Pepper 'Purple Flash'**
- Other ornamental peppers are grown for their fruit. This one has beautiful leaves all season.
- 77  **Salvia farinacea 'Victoria Blue' or similar**
- Ideal companion to marigolds, begonias, etc but also effective in containers and perennial beds.
- 78  **Salvia coccinea Summer Jewel Red**
- Earlier to flower and slightly more compact than 'Lady in Red'. Grows 20" tall.
- 79  **Sanvitalia - Creeping Zinnia**
- An alternative to marigolds, Helenium 'Dakota Gold', and Melampodium for pots or beds. 6-8" tall.
- 80  **Scaevola - Fan Flower**
- No maintenance trailer for containers BUT also underused as a heat tolerant groundcover.
- 81  **Setcreasea pallida 'Variegata'**
- For sun or shade. Excellent compliment to contrasting flowers OR leaves. About 10" tall.
